1. A free shot given to a player after a foul or a technical foul. The player shoots from the 15-foot free throw line while the rest of the players line up along the outside of the key.

3. A penalty, which results in a turnover, where an offensive player moves his or her pivot foot illegally or takes three steps without dribbling the ball.

4. This penalty, which results in a turnover, occurs when a player dribbles the ball with both hands. It also occurs when a player dribbles, stops dribbling, and then begins to dribble again.

<u>ACROSS</u>

2. A shot at the basket that misses everything and doesn't touch the rim, backboard or net.

5. A shot taken close to the hoop, usually when a player is moving toward the basket.

6. When the offensive team loses possession of the ball by way of an offensive foul, steal or out-of-bounds violation.

7. When one player jumps and catches a pass from another player and simultaneously dunks the ball or shoots it in before landing.

8. A made basket where the ball avoids the rim and touches nothing but the net, creating a "swish" sound.

9. The rectangular piece of wood or fiberglass the rim is attached to.

10. When a player from either team retrieves the ball and gains possession after a missed shot.
